METAL • GLASS • PLASTIC

Tin & Beverage Cans, License Plates, Glass Bottles and Jars (without the lids), No. 1 & 2 Plastic Containers that hold soda, detergent, shampoo, milk and water

PAPER • CARDBOARD

Newspapers, Magazines, Sunday Inserts, Corrugated Cardboard - identifiable by its ribbed middle layer, usually brown in color

NOT WRAP MATERIAL*

Milk and Egg Cartons, Cereal Boxes, Food/Pizza Boxes, Gift Boxes, etc.

All Plastic Bags, Toys, Buckets, Coolers, Kitchen Utensils, etc.

Any Metal Hangers, Pots and Pans, Kitchen Utensils, etc.

Glass from Windows, Dishes and Drinking or Eye Glasses, Ceramics, Mirrors, etc.

accessible to residents 7 a.m. to 2:45 p.m., Mon. thru Fri.
FREE drop-off of waste oil, batteries, e-waste, and household hazardous waste (excluding controlled substances and ammunition) for residents

Three Bulk Metal items are collected every Wednesday (washer, refrigerator, bike, etc.)

E-waste materials will be collected on the last Wednesday of every month (electronic items)
